Re: A-One+ are the Managing Agent Contractor (MAC) working for and on behalf of the Highways Agency for the Trunk Road and Motorway network in the East Midlands (Area 7).

M1 J15 Gyratory Resurfacing Scheme

We would like to inform you of our intention to carry out road works at Junction 15 of the M1

The road surface on the junction is severely worn, this scheme will resurface the road with a quieter material, giving better riding quality and significantly improving road safety.

The works will be carried out during the night over two weekends :

Northern Half: Friday, 19th February 22.00 until 05:00 on Monday 22nd February 2010.

Southern Half: Friday 26th February 22.00 until 05.00 on Monday 1st March 2010.

The weekend night working time has been chosen because that is when the lowest traffic flows occur thereby causing the least impact on the travelling public. The intended working times are:

Friday	22:00-08:00 (Sat)
Saturday	20:00-09:00 (Sun)
Sunday	22:00-05:00 (Mon)

The junction will be partially closed, including the slip roads leading to and from the M1 to all traffic other than emergency vehicles between these times

We have included a Journey Planner overleaf which contains the details of the closures and the diversion routes that will be available during the works..

Closure of northern part of junction (19 – 22 February)

Overnight for one weekend the southbound entry and exit slip roads and the bridge over the motorway at M1 J15 will be closed. Southbound traffic will leave or join the motorway at J15a (Rothersthorpe), and the A45-A508 route across the motorway will be closed.

M1 southbound traffic for the A45 and Grange Park will exit at J15A follow the A5123 towards Northampton then the A5076 Danes Camp Way/ Mereway to rejoin the A45 at the Queen Eleanor junction. Traffic heading from the A45 or Grange Park to the M1 in either direction will follow the reverse route to join at J15A. Grange Park traffic will not be able to join or leave the A45 at J15 but will instead use Cheaney Drive roundabout to proceed north on Saxon Avenue.

M1 southbound traffic for the A508 will exit at J15A and follow the A43 and A5 through Towcester to the A508 at Old Stratford roundabout.

Traffic heading between the A45 and the A508, both ways, will follow the diversion via A5, A43, A5123 and A5076, though northbound traffic between A508 and A45 may alternatively join M1 north between J15 and J15A (this alternative route is not suitable for non-motorway traffic).

M1 northbound traffic for the A45 will proceed to J15A and follow A5123 and A5076.

A508 traffic for the M1 southbound will join the motorway northbound at J15 and proceed to J15A where it will exit and rejoin the motorway southbound

Closure of southern part of junction (26 February – 1 March)

Overnight for one weekend the northbound entry and exit slip roads and the bridge over the motorway at J15 will be closed. Northbound traffic will leave or join the motorway at J15A (Rothersthorpe), and the A45-A508 route across the motorway will be closed.

M1 northbound traffic for the A45 and Grange Park will proceed to J15A and use the A5123 and A5076 Danes Camp Way/Mereway to rejoin the A45 at the Queen Eleanor junction. Traffic heading from the A45 or Grange Park to the northbound M1 will follow the reverse route, via A5076 and A5123 to join at J15A.

M1 northbound traffic for the A508 will proceed to J15A then follow A43 and A5 via Towcester to rejoin A508 at Old Stratford roundabout, but may instead leave the motorway at J14. A508 traffic for the M1 in either direction will follow the reverse route via A5 and A43 to J15A.

Traffic heading between the A45 or Grange Park and the A508, both ways, will follow the diversion via A5, A43, A5123 and A5076.

M1 southbound traffic for the A508 will exit at J15A and follow the A43 and A5 through Towcester.
